# BATTERY MAINTENANCE and CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. You **MUST** charge completely prior to initial use. (Follow charging instructions in your Product Handbook)
- 2. Charge immediately after each use.
- 3. Charge before storage. You must charge every 30 days if not in use.
- 4. Charge the unit for 6-7 hours or until the light on the charger turns red & green.
- 5. **DO NOT** allow this unit to deep discharge the battery.
- 6. For safety purposes, **DO NOT** charge for over 24 hours.
- 7. Turn the unit **OFF** when not in use.

#### QUICK REFERENCE SAFETY GUIDE

## SAFETY GUIDE

- The recommended minimum age for riding this electric scooter is 16 years old.
- To avoid damage to the motor and footplate, do not overload the electric scooter.
- Never ride with more than one person.
- Inspect your electric scooter thoroughly before each use for loose or missing parts.
- Avoid unintentional starts by turning the electric scooter off while not in use.
- To avoid the risk of a short circuit in the electrical parts, do not use your Electric scooter in the rain and never spray or wash off your Electric scooter with water.
- Do not place the battery near fire or heat.
- To avoid damage to the battery, do not use the charger if it has been damaged in any way.
- Keep hands, face, feet and hair away from all moving parts.
- Do not touch the motor or wheels while they are rotating.
- Brakes are designed to control speed as well as stop the electric scooter. Practice braking for proper slowing down and smooth stops.
- Maintain your Electric scooter as recommended in this product handbook.
- Use only quality replacement parts as recommended by the manufacturer.
- Inspect the entire Electric scooter prior to each use. Replace any part that is cracked, chipped or damaged before use.

\*NEVER ALLOW CHILDREN TO OPERATE THE ELECTRIC SCOOTER.



### **OPERATION OF SCOOTER**

#### 1. Ignition


Insert key into ignition and turn clockwise to turn the scooter on. The battery indicator bars will display the current charge level when on. Turn the key counter-clockwise to power off when stopped.

Note: if you want to lock the steering bar, first turn the handbar left then Turn the key anticlockwise to lock position to lock the steering bar.



#### 2. LCD DISPLAY

We can operated the button on display to control the spped and lights.




#### **3.Circuit Breaker**

The blue circuit breaker switch underneath the seat must be turned on to operate the scooter, and must remain on while charging.

#### CHARGING

Your Electric scooter comes charged out of the package. We still recommend charging the unit for 6-7 hours prior to it's first use. We also recommend charging your electric scooter after each use and prior to storage.

WARNING: Do not allow your Electric scooter to go into deep discharge, as this will damage the batteries.

- 1. Make sure unit is turned off.(Ignition off but circuit breaker should be ON position)
- 2. Open the charging socket cover located on the rear of the plastic parts under the seat .
- 3. Locate your Battery Charger. Find the charger socket, and plug it into the Electric scooter .
- 4. Next, plug the AC plug into a wall outlet.

When first plugged in, the charger has one red light that will illuminate at the same time, indicating that the charging process has started. Once the light on the charger turns red & green, you may remove the charger and close the safety cap.

#### MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

Proper care of your Electric scooter will insure optimal performance and longer life span. The following are a few maintenance suggestions that will keep your Electric scooter running in top condition:

#### Daily Maintenance

Perform each time you ride your Electric scooter

- Clean the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp rag. (DO NOT WASH WITH A HOSE)
- Check that all nuts and bolts are securely tightened.
- Lubricate the chain with any silicone spray, 3&1 oil or any good clean motor oil.
- Check battery charger for any frayed/cut wires.
